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

Revised Information for IE Bulletin 80-11, 180 Day Response

Gentlemen:

By letter dated September 20, 1994 (0CAN099402), Entergy Operations determined that six additional walls for the Arkansas Nuclear One units should have been included in the final report required by the 180 day response to IE Bulletin 80-11, "Masonry Wall Design." The wall modifications to meet the requirements of IE Bulletin 80-11 were to be installed by the end of 1R13 which is currently scheduled to begin September 17, 1996. As a part of the control room emergency air conditioning system design change modification, one of the three ANO-2 walls (24B-219/220) will be removed by the end of 2R12 which is currently scheduled to begin April 11, 1997. Removal of this wall will remove it from the scope of the bulletin; therefore, wall 24B-219/220 will not be modified due to its future removal.
