SUBJECT: Revision 12 to the Fort Calhoun Station (FCS) Site Security Plan

The Omaha Public Power District (OPPD) is providing Revision 12 to the FCS Site Security Plan (SSP). This revision has been determined not to degrade the effectiveness of current security plans, and has been approved in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p).

Revision 12 to the FCS SSP, including a detailed summary listing of changes, is enclosed. This revision contains details on the modification of the Protected Area (PA) barrier within the security building to move the training room and break room into the PA. The ability to provide training, break and staging areas inside the PA significantly enhances the overall effectiveness of the security program by reducing the amount of response time to normal, emergency or contingency events for security officers responding from these areas. In addition, an administrative change was made to convert the SSP from WordPerfect 5.1 to 6.1, which required a change in the fonts. All changes are identified with revision bars in the right margin, with the exception of the fonts.

This submittal contains safeguards information and must be controlled in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21. Controlled copy numbers 6, 7 and 18 are enclosed for the Document Control Desk. Controlled copy numbers 19 and 20 are being transmitted to Region IV. Controlled copy number 8 is being transmitted to the FCS Senior Resident Inspector.


