Dear Mr. Quay:

Enclosed in an isometric drawing (PL01-V2-007) for the AP600 surge line. The isometric identifies the correct bend radii and layout to be used in the piping model for the surge line. This information is provided in support of the effort by Brookhaven National Laboratory to develop AP600 specific benchmark problems for piping stress analysis. A copy is being sent directly to G. Degross of BNL.

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
