Anthony/FOE appeals all the decisions of ASLB, LBP-85-14, involving emergency planning for a nuclear accident at PECO's Limerick plant, especially the Board's denial of prejudiced and pressured methods used on intervenors in the hearings, <sup>faulty</sup> evacuation time estimates and traffic volumes, and failure to recognize the congestion and potential blockages in the Valley Forge park and King of Prussia areas as set forth in LEA-24/FOE-1 contentions.

We petition the Appeal Board to reverse ASLB's decisions and to find in favor of the intervenors on the basis of the record and the findings of the intervenors. We believe ASLB erred seriously in not recognizing the severe threat to the safety of the users of Valley Forge Park from the park not being included in emergency planning for the EPZ and actually added to the EPZ area.
