The information Nuclear Awareness Network seeks is limited to the period of time beginning on June 20, 1984, and extending to August 20, 1984.

2) All drafts of NRC memos, from June 20 to August 20, 1984, related to the Nuclear Awareness Network's petition to relocate the LPDR.
