

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of our current plans for completion of Limerick Generating Station, Unit 2. At this time, Unit 2 is approximately 30% complete and its construction has been suspended pending the results of the Limerick Unit No. 2 investigation currently being conducted by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission.

In accordance with our presentation in the PUC proceeding, it is our plan to resume construction in October, 1985 assuming favorable rulings from the Administrative Law Judge and the full Public Utilities Commission.
