Gentlemen:

The attached Entergy Operations, Inc. Semiannual Radioactive Effluent Release Report tables have been updated to reflect changes to data previously submitted for the 1989 third quarter reporting period (Ref. AECM-90/0046, dated February 28, 1990). Tables 1A and 1C included radio-iodine data which had been detected in noble gas grab samples and reported in the Fission and Activation Gases category. Additional review of the release data revealed that radio-iodines detected in noble gas samples should not have been reported in the Fission and Activation Gases Category. The Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Sampling and Analysis Program considers and reports all iodine releases in the Iodine category. This revision deletes radio-iodine from the Fission and Activation Gases Category.

Additionally, previously submitted Semiannual Radioactive Effluent Release Reports were reviewed to determine if similar inconsistencies existed. The 10CFR50, Appendix I doses for the above, as well as previous, reporting period are correct as reported.

This Update is submitted in compliance with the requirements of 10CFR 50.36a(a)(2) and the GGNS Technical Specifications 6.9.1.8, 6.9.1.9 and 6.14

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
