Emergency Response Procedure Revisions

Dear Sir:

Enclosed is Revision No. 1 to Emergency Response Procedure (ERP)-300, "TSC/MCR Dose Assessment Team." This procedure is required to be submitted within thirty (30) days of its revision in accordance with the requirements of 10CFR50, Appendix E, and 10CFR50.4. To comply with these requirements, the procedure revision should have been submitted by August 14, 1992. However, due to an oversight on the part of personnel processing the revision, we are submitting it sixteen (16) days late.

We are requesting that this procedure (i.e., ERP-300, Rev. 1) be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10CFR2.790(a)(6) because it contains names and telephone numbers, and disclosure of this information would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of the individuals involved.

Also, note that in our letter dated August 10, 1992, submitting Emergency Procedure Revisions, the Emergency Response Procedure Index was incorrectly identified as Revision No. 1. The revision actually submitted was Revision No. 3.


