Dear Mr. Goyle:

This is to acknowledge receipt of the revised NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated February 26, 2020, signed by you and received in our offices on March 16, 2020. As this document lacked responses to Items 1 and 2 below, we are unable to complete our review and require additional information to proceed with your request to terminate Materials License 34-23477-02. We further identified that information in Item 3 was lacking as well.

We find that we need the following additional information:

1. Item B.2, "Disposal of Radioactive Material" on this form was incomplete. If it is your intention to terminate this license, you must complete Item B.2 appropriately.
2. This same form indicated that your radioactive materials were transferred to Cline's Technical Services, Inc. ("CTS") and that a copy of CTS's Ohio Radioactive Material ("RAM") License No. 3225230000 was attached.

It was not attached. Please respond by including a current, signed, dated and unredacted copy of CTS's Ohio RAM License to support CTS's acquisition of your licensed materials.

3. Please provide a written, dated and signed acknowledgment of receipt from CTS clearly stating that they took possession of your licensed materials on a specified date. CTS's letter should include the manufacturer's name, model number and serial number for each sealed source and device transferred, as well as the radionuclides' identities and activities.

Within 15 days of the date of this letter (by close of business on May 11, 2020) please provide only one response to the items below.

Please only send us one complete, written, currently dated and legibly, physically signed (by an appropriate senior management official) or digitally signed correspondence document, such as either an NRC Form 313 or a business-style letter containing the same information as an NRC Form 313a.

Please ensure that only one correspondence letter is used that shows both the date and the signature of the senior management official, in contrast to the two separate, incomplete correspondence letters initiating this request.

Please ensure that the requested information is answered completely and accurately.

Please do not send multiple copies of responses and please do not submit any information that is identical to what you have already sent us unless we direct you to do so. If you resubmit such information for the sake of adding context and other details to enhance its meaning, that is acceptable.

Please do not email a PDF document to me, and transmit a faxed version, and/or a hard copy sent by mail. Only one copy transmitted in only one of these ways is appropriate to prevent administrative processing errors, although emailing a PDF document is the least efficient mechanism for responding to me.

Please address your written response to my attention as "additional information to control number 618173," to facilitate proper handling in our offices.

Please also schedule a telephone call with me and Ms. Colleen Carol Casey, who is assisting me with this review, to discuss our requests for additional information ("RAI") above.

A telephone discussion of these items is expected to serve to clarify the information required by our regulations so that your response will be complete and accurate.

In addition, please be reminded that 10 CFR 30.9(a) requires: "(a) Information provided to the Commission by an applicant for a license or by a licensee or information required by statute or by the Commission's regulations, orders, or license conditions to be maintained by the applicant or the licensee shall be complete and accurate in all material respects."
