Gentlemen:

Pursuant to 10CFR50.59(b), the following items are submitted for the Kansas State University TRIGA Mk II Nuclear Reactor Facility for the period 1 Oct 91 through 30 Sep 92.

A. Changes in the Facility:

At their meeting of 5 Mar 92, the Reactor Safeguards Committee approved final implementation of a new physical security system meeting specifications of a revised Physical Security Plan which had been approved by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on 5 Jul 91. The Committee found that implementation of the system would constitute no threat to the integrity of the reactor or to the health and safety of workers and the public.

B. Changes to Procedures:

Revisions of the following procedures were approved by ballot of the Reactor Safeguards Committee at their meeting of 5 Mar 92:

Revision of Procedure No. 17 - *Periodic Reactor Intrusion Alarm Testing*. The procedure was revised to be in accord with a newly installed physical security system (Item A, above). The Committee found that implementation of the revised procedure would involve no risk to the integrity of the reactor or to the health and safety of worker and the public.

Revision of Procedure No. 1 - *Isotope Production*. The revision was made in order to meet a Nuclear Regulatory Commission request that we account for activities of neutron-activation analysis samples transferred from the Reactor Facility to State of Kansas Licensees. In addition, the revision permits State of Kansas licensees to designate in writing those employees authorized to receive radioactive materials. The Committee found that implementation of the revised procedure would involve no risk to the integrity of the reactor or to the health and safety of worker and the public.

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
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At their meeting of 18 Sep 92 the Reactor Safeguards Committee approved editorial revisions of the Reactor Facility Emergency Plan to incorporate new Protective Action Guides released by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA 400-R-92-011, Oct 91). This was done in accordance with NRC Information Notice 92-18.
