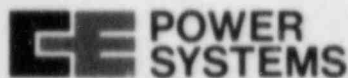

Dear Mr. Miller:

In response to your letter of May 10, 1985 and NRC Bill Number D0277, please be advised that the fee for the NRC review of Reference (1) is incorrectly addressed to Combustion Engineering. CEN-203 was submitted to the NRC via Reference (2) by the Combustion Engineering Owners Group (CEOG) and, therefore, the assessment of any review fee on Combustion Engineering, Inc., is in error.
