Dear Mr. Schregardus:

I appreciate your invitation to attend a meeting of the agencies and public officials directly involved in the cleanup of low-level radioactive materials at the Bert Avenue and Harvard Avenue sites in Newburgh Heights in order to expedite the remediation process.

Your stated purpose for the meeting is to discuss Ohio's regulatory concerns with our final site remediation plan and to respond to questions and concerns that Chemetron may have.

My impression is that the State of Ohio is now rigidly interpreting Chemetron's proposed remediation as the installation of a solid waste landfill. My advisors inform us that there are precedents for alternative interpretations.

Chemetron wants to explore the alternatives under which it could quickly and safely complete this long-delayed cleanup. I welcome the opportunity to attend a meeting that considers a regulatory framework for the remediation proposed by Chemetron, and request that the agenda include discussion of the following:

1. Remediation under Section 3734.20 of the ORC

This is the section of the code generally used for remediation of old landfills containing either solid or hazardous waste.

2. An enforcement order under Section 3734.13 of the ORC

The Director may issue an order directing a cleanup.

3. An exemption under Section 3734.02(G) of the ORC

The Director may grant an exemption from the requirement to obtain a solid waste permit.



4. Invoking the general powers of the OEPA under Section 3745.01 of the ORC.
