Subject: Special Safety Inspection No. 030-14914/92-001

On September 24 and 25, 1992, and October 15, 1992, Messrs. Thomas K. Thompson and David B. Everhart of this office conducted a special safety inspection at the licensee's facilities located at 5100 Paxton Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania and Adam's County Paving Quarry, Hummelstown, Pennsylvania, and at field sites located at Route 74, south of Carlisle, Pennsylvania and Mount Holly, Pennsylvania of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. This inspection was also conducted to review previously identified apparent violations. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. The findings of the inspection were discussed with Michael Wick and Guy Talbot of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. A Notice of Violation is enclosed as Appendix A and categorizes each violation by severity level in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (Enforcement Policy). You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

Item B in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter was identified during a previous inspection of your licensed activities and documented in a Notice of Violation enclosed with our letter dated December 4, 1991. From this inspection, it appears that your corrective actions were not effective since this item has recurred. Recurrent and uncorrected violations are given additional weight in the consideration and selection of appropriate enforcement action. Therefore, in your response to this letter, you should give particular attention to those actions taken or planned to ensure that identified items of noncompliance will be completely corrected and will not recur.
