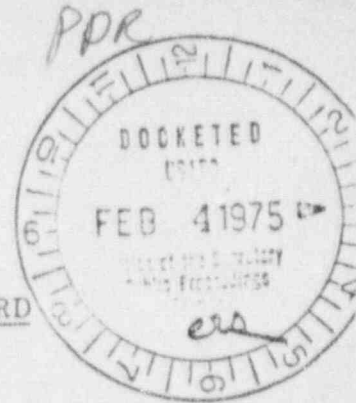


ORDER
