I. SECY-92-384 - Piping Specialists, Inc.'s Petition for Review  
of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's Final Initial  
Decision (LBP-92-25) Sustaining Staff's Suspension and  
Revocation Orders and Terminating the Proceeding

The Commission, by a 5-0\* vote, approved an order responding to a petition from Piping Specialists, Inc. (PSI) requesting Commission review of a Licensing Board Decision (LBP-92-25) which revoked the byproduct material license held by PSI. The order denied the licensee's petition for review.

(Subsequently, on December 1, 1992, the Assistant Secretary signed the Order.)

\* Section 201 of the Energy Reorganization Act, 42 U.S.C. §5841, provides that action of the Commission shall be determined by a "majority vote of the members present." Chairman Selin was not present when this item was affirmed. Accordingly, the formal vote of the Commission was 4-0 in favor of the decision. Chairman Selin, however, had previously indicated that he would approve this paper and had he been present he would have affirmed his prior vote.
