Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed all necessary data to apply for an N.R.C. license.

In regard to training and experience Mr. O.C. Lamascus, Radiation Safety Officer of the company, has gained experience and education from four companies over the past 20 years. The first was P.G.A.C. They merged with Dresser Atlas Corporation in the 60's. The next was Go Jet Services out of Oklahoma City, which later formed Go International, Inc., Ft. Worth, Texas, part of the Gearhart-Owen Industries. Mr. Lamascus continued services with them until 1976, where he was Radiation Protection Officer for the District with the responsibilities of verification of inventories, records, and material usage, survey records, training and education of district personnel, leak tests and survey meter calibrations. 
PERFORATING LOGGING
