

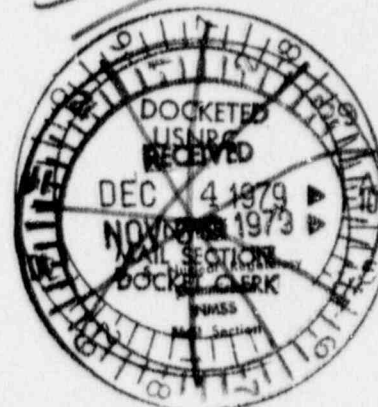
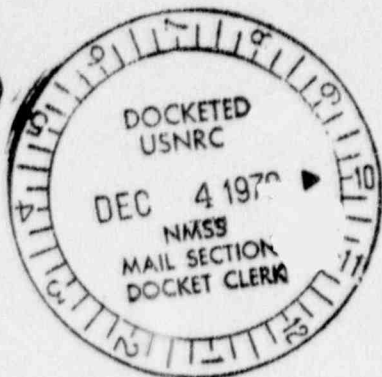


The details and discussions concerning this request are presented in the attached document, with additional information contained in other documents submitted to the U.S.N.R.C. as referenced in the attached document.
