This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. Colleen C. Casey and Mr. Michael F. Weber of this office on August 7 through November 3, 1992, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 12-02642-06, and to review an NRC concern relating to the V. A. Lakeside Medical Center radiation safety program. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you, Mr. David Beery, and Mr. Eli Port.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.
