I am in receipt of the NRC's letter dated November 25, 1992. On December 3, 1992 I held a telephone conversation with Mr. Richard Bangart where the letter was briefly discussed. As promised in that phone call I met with my in-house staff and representatives on our consulting firm to review the contents of your letter.


Both my staff and I were surprised at the contents of the letter. It was my staff's feeling that during the past 6 months great strides have been made by both the NRC and Envirocare in the licensing process. During that time hundreds of concerns have been resolved and worthwhile communication has existed between the two organizations. The contents of the letter do not reflect the progress that has been made.

After a careful and detailed study of the existing documents and facts related to the general inadequacies suggested in the letter, it was concluded that the issues raised have been presented inaccurately and at best lack the necessary factual basis.

To illustrate and document our position, I have requested that my staff prepare a complete report for your review. I will present this report to you during our meeting of December 21, 1992.

In as much as Envirocare has suffered significant financial review cost and has been a subject of numerous unnecessary criticism, I will continue to be responsive to the needs and requirements of the agency.
