Joseph Califano told Senate Health and Science sub-committee that residents near the plant will continue to be exposed to low-level for "months and years. The dosage that these people were subjected to was so small, he testified that even if all 25,000 persons within five miles of the plant absorbed the maximum dose, we would still expect to find no additional cancer deaths" beyond what is normally expected. How can they say these plants should run if they know how many people have cancer, as he stated "what is normally expected".

Despite the Three Mile Island nuclear plant accident, The New York Power Pool yesterday (April 3) urged nuclear power for the state's future - including construction of eight nuclear plants in the state. I am totally against their construction. But if all our fighting fails these plants had better meet with our requests, and

better be built safely away from
fault lines and people. The New York
Power Pool wants them to be built in
Buchanan, Shoreham plant, Suffolk County,
Greene County, Cayuga County, James-
port, New Haven, Oswego County. All
