Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. Kinneman of this office on November 5 and 6, 1975 at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, of activities authorized by your Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) General License and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. J. Kinneman with Mr. Repp of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection and to a subsequent telephone conversation between Mr. J. Kinneman and yourself on November 10, 1975.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your NRC General License as they relate to compliance with the NRC's Regulation 10 CFR 150 "Exemptions and Continued Regulatory Authority in Agreement States under Section 274." The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
