CHAIRMAN SELIN'S COMMENTS ON SECY-92-366, PROPOSED LICENSE, UNDER  
10 CFR PART 72, FOR DRY CONCRETE MODULE STORAGE OF SPENT FUEL AT  
BALTIMORE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S CALVERT CLIFFS NUCLEAR POWER  
PLANT SITE

I approve issuance of the proposed license to Baltimore Gas and Electric Company, as recommended by the staff in SECY-92-366.

In connection with this action I note that this seems to be a routine licensing action, of a type which I do not believe necessarily warrants Commission review and approval. I therefore request that the Office of General Counsel consider rulemaking as necessary to eliminate any requirement for Commission authorization prior to the NRC staff issuance of specific licenses under 10 CFR Part 72 for independent spent fuel storage installations, including specifically the requirement for such authorization contained in 10 CFR 2.764(c). Avoiding unnecessary Commission review will ease the burdens of both the staff and the Commission, and reduce fees charged to license applicants.
