Dear Mr. Fong:

On August 22, 1975, Mr. F.F. McConnell, Manager of ERDA Wood Waste Pilot Plant, Albany, Oregon wrote to Mr. Ray Lull of Maecon, Inc. stating that he (Mr. McConnell) had been verbally informed by Mr. Bassin of the NRC that ERDA installations are exempt from radioactive materials licensing.

This information was forwarded to Kay-Ray, Inc. via Ms. Randy Lowe of Wiscomb, Weidner Co., purchaser of the equipment, on September 3, 1975 along with a copy of Mr. McConnell's letter to Mr. Lull. These two letters, copies of which are enclosed, served as the authority for Kay-Ray to ship the four gauges to Maecon, Inc. at the Bureau of Mines.

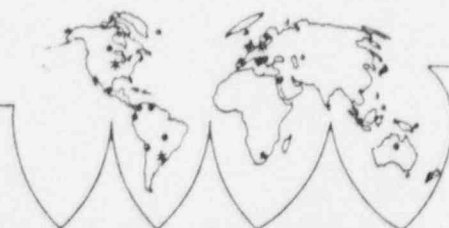

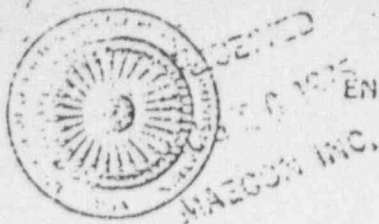

RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL LICENSE

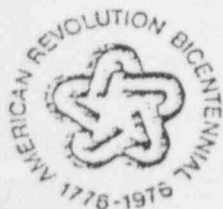
