
Dear Ms. Carter-White:

This refers to your letter dated November 20, 1992, requesting information regarding monitoring well data for certain monitoring points at the Sequoyah facility in Gore, Oklahoma. As was discussed during the December 1, 1992, telephone conversation between you and Mr. G. M. Vasquez and Ms. L. L. Kasner of my staff, Sequoyah Fuels Corporation is not required to routinely submit reports to NRC for data gathered during sampling of the two monitoring points referenced in your letter.

However, NRC inspectors periodically review data available at the Sequoyah facility during routine inspections. Although NRC does not maintain a file of the data reviewed by the inspectors, the inspectors' findings are documented in formal inspection reports. As was noted by Mr. Vasquez and Ms. Kasner, recent inspections performed by Region IV inspectors did include a review of data generated through routine sampling of the denitration subfloor monitor. The inspectors' findings are documented in NRC Inspection Report Nos. 40-8027/92-24 and 92-25, dated September 17 and October 13, 1992. Copies of these reports are enclosed with this letter.
