RE: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. §552) and the NRC's regulations (10 C.F.R. §9.3, et seq.), Bishop, Liberman, Cook, Purcell and Reynolds requests copies of all letters, reports, meeting minutes, manuals, memoranda, guidelines, testimony or other documents related to the NRC's plans, policies, and procedures for implementing newly promulgated 10 C.F.R. Part 170, 49 Fed. Reg. 21293 (May 21, 1984).

The regulation establishes that many license and inspection fees will be based on actual costs, as calculated from a total of professional staff hours and associated support and contractual service costs expended in performing the review or inspection.

This request includes but is not limited to the following:

1. Documents which reflect preliminary or final views on which NRC personnel and expenses will be included as charges in license and inspection fees based on actual costs.
2. Documents which establish the preliminary or final plans, policies, or procedures for recording and attributing NRC professional hours and associated support hours for inclusion in license or inspection fees.
3. Documents which reflect preliminary or final views on which NRC expenses related to contested licensing hearings will be included in license or inspection fees.


