Therefore, Be It Resolved by the East Side Democratic Club of Multnomah County as follows:

That a request be addressed to the authorities involved that the plant remain closed until a public adjudicatory hearing be held involving the initiators of the NRC Reports, knowledgeable nuclear scientists, PGE and DOE representatives and concerned citizens.
