A review of the petition contained in the Federal Register (Docket No. PRM-71-7, Non Destructive Testing Management Association, Et Al) dated June 14, 1978 invokes the following protests.

- (a) Appendix E of 10CFR, Part 71 is apparently imposed on the industry without an interchange of communication much less proof of necessity.
- (b) We are concerned with soaring costs and wish to avoid mountains of paperwork and records which will result. We have far too many regulations to comply with and can do without unnecessary ones such as Appendix E of Part 71.
