Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 03 to your NRC License No. SMC-1377 which authorizes you to operate as specified in your May 9, 1985 letter through September 30, 1985. As indicated in your letter and subsequent conversation with the NRC staff, you intend to close your facility by September 30, 1985 and will not pursue license renewal.

Please note that Condition 13. requires you to decontaminate your facilities at 3131 St. Clair Avenue, E. St. Louis, Illinois and submit a radiation survey report to the NRC by September 30, 1985 and prior to releasing the facilities for unrestricted use. Enclosed are the NRC guidelines for decontamination of facilities and equipment.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. You must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:

1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.
2. Possess radioactive material only in the quantity and form indicated in your license.
3. Use radioactive material only for the purpose(s) indicated in your license.
4. Notify NRC in writing of any change in mailing address.
5. Request and obtain appropriate amendment if you plan to change ownership of your organization, change locations of radioactive material, or make any other changes in your facility or program which are contrary to your license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with NRC. Any amendment request should be accompanied by the appropriate fee specified in 10 CFR Part 170.

6. Operate in accordance with the regulations specified in Section 40.42(d)(1) and (e) of 10 CFR Part 40, "Domestic Licensing of Source Material".

Upon completion of your facility decontamination survey and transfer of materials, our office will be conducting an independent survey of the facility to verify compliance with 10 CFR 40.42(d).
