

REQUEST FOR ACTION UNDER 10 CFR SECTION 2.206

Notice is hereby given that, by letter dated August 29, 1984, certain citizens of East St. Louis, Illinois (Petitioners), seek removal of the Edlow International source material storage site presently located in East St. Louis, Illinois. The letter is being treated as a Petition pursuant to 10 CFR Section 2.206. (Any other letters received by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission which make similar requests regarding Edlow will be consolidated into this Petition.) The Petition claims that the Edlow site is currently located in a densely populated neighborhood including a number of schools with substantial student bodies. The Petition further claims that the fire which occurred at the facility on December 7, 1983 and the violations disclosed as a result of that fire indicate that the radioactive material stored at the facility poses a threat to public health and safety. Specifically, the adequacy of evacuation of citizens in the event of an emergency is questioned. Appropriate action will be taken on the Petition within a reasonable time. A copy of the Petition is available for inspection in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. 20555.
