Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 01 to your NRC License Number 14-18626-02 per your letter of April 26, 1985.

Item V of your above referenced letter appears to exempt certain packages containing licensed material from safe opening procedures. There are no exemptions from safe opening procedures in 10 CFR 20.205. Basically, 10 CFR 20.205 is divided into four parts:

- a. Paragraph (b) refers to monitoring for surface contamination upon receipt of packages containing licensed material. This contains the exemption quoted in Item V of your letter.
- b. Paragraph (d) refers to procedures for safely opening packages containing licensed material. There are not exemptions in Paragraph (d).

Therefore, we have not incorporated this request into your license.

Be advised we have not authorized Drs. Foy, Stoecker, and Tokuyama to use materials at your hospital. In order to add Dr. Tokuyama you will need to submit a Preceptor Statement signed by his preceptors (Dr. T. Ju and Dr. J. Goldfarb). Also, the total number of hours received in clinical radioisotope training should be specified in Item 3 of Supplement B and the dates of this training must be within the last five years. You will also need to submit a copy of Supplement A of the Preceptor Package which outlines the didactic training Dr. Tokuyama has received.

In order to add Dr. Foy to your license you will need to submit completed Supplements A and B. of the enclosed Preceptor Package documenting his training and experience.

In order to add Dr. Stoecker to your license you will need to submit a completed Supplement A of the Preceptor Package which documents the didactic training Dr. Stoecker has received.

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Since your license is issued in the name of Des Moines General Hospital, please be sure that all future license amendments or renewal requests are signed by the institution's administrator. This will assure us that the administration concurs with your proposed activities.

Information submitted in response to this letter should state that it is additional information and not a new amendment request. If you have questions, please contact our office by dialing (312) 790-5625.


