12. DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT/MODIFICATION

The purpose of this modification is to make additions to the Scope of Work, add a requirement under the Quarterly Reports Section and increase the total amount of the contract by \$25,000.

Changes:

I. Under Article I, Scope of Work, add the following:

"The State's radiation control staff will consult with the State Patrol staff and review and inspect radioactive waste shipments at the two border crossing point at I 90 near Spokane and Plymouth where waste is permitted to enter Washington."

"The State will attempt to inspect all proposed radioactive waste shipments originating in Washington prior to such shipments being placed in vehicles. A minimum number of 20 inspections will be performed prior to September 10, 1980."

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in block 8, as hereinafter changed, remain unchanged and shall be in full force and effect.

"The State's radiation control staff will be stationed at the Nuclear Engineering Company site at Richland at all times while it is operating to assure that all shipments received are in compliance with applicable regulations. If for any reason the State fails to inspect an incoming shipment at NECO, the date of that shipment shall be included in the Quarterly Report."

II. Under Section J, Quarterly Reports, add the following:

"5. A listing of the dates and hours when surveillance was performed, the type and number of personnel utilized, and a breakdown of all other costs incurred during the reporting quarter."

III. Under Article V, Contract Administration Data, delete the first sentence under item B, Consideration, and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

"The Commission shall pay the State a fixed sum of \$45,000 for the one-year period specified in this contract, chargeable to the appropriation (DOT) cited in Block 14, Page 1."

This modification results in an increase of "\$25,000" from "\$20,000" to "\$45,000".


