However, the CEC disputes this "fact" insofar as it suggests either: 1) that the Board is restrained from requiring such a system at Rancho Seco; or 2) that a controlled filtered venting system would not provide substantial, additional protection of the public health and safety. 10 C.F.R. section 50.109; Affidavit of Daniel Nix ("Nix") paragraph 4; California Energy Commission's Response to Licensee's Motion for Summary Disposition of Contention 5-2 by the California Energy Commission ("Response"), passim.

4. A controlled filtered venting system such as that proposed by CEC would include rupture discs in the containment which would rupture at pressures at or below the containment design pressure. Dieterich, para. 6.

The CEC disputes this fact insofar as it suggests that controlled filtered venting would lessen the designed containment capability of Rancho Seco. Nix paragraph 4; Response p. 3-5.


5. A controlled filtered venting system such as that proposed by CEC is not available commercially Dieterich, para. 7.

6. A controlled filtered venting system such as that proposed by CEC has not been developed, and there has been no demonstration of the effectiveness, reliability or safety of such system. Dieterich, para. 7.

The CEC disputes these facts insofar as they suggest that the expertise necessary to establish the feasibility of implementing a controlled filtered venting system at Ranch Seco is not commercially available. Nix paragraph 5; Response p. 7-8.

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
