SUBJECT: ALLEGATION REGARDING INTEGRITY

On June 5, 1990, the senior resident inspector at the Millstone Nuclear Power Station received a phone call, documented in the enclosed record, which suggests NRC impropriety. Specifically, it states that "the NRC is covering up crimes by NU" (Northeast Utilities). An allegation panel met on June 6 to review the document and has made a determination on the required NRC followup. Based on that review, we will respond to [redacted] in writing on the technical issue and we are referring the alleged impropriety to you.

This memorandum does not request any action, but is forwarded to you for information and what further action you deem necessary. If you have any questions, please call me or William Kane of my staff.
