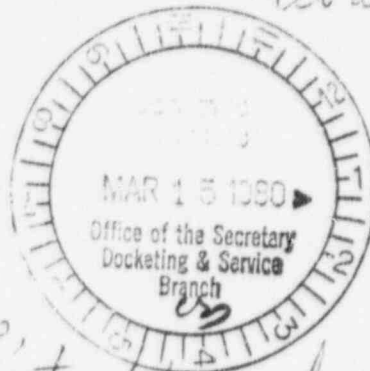

Dear Commissioners,

I am writing to let you know of my concerns with the Limerick, Pa. nuclear power plant. I am from Bucks County where we have been appalled at PECO's request for our Delaware River water. I have recently learned that when a drought occurs the Merrill Creek in New Jersey will open its (uncompleted) dam. (And let's face it, the sole purpose of this project is for the Limerick nuclear plant.) The water is extracted via pipeline at Point Pleasant and pumped to a PECO owned reservoir, then it flows to the E. branch of the Ruckomeen Creek until it gets to its destination miles away.

Another of my concerns with this topic is, I am one of the 3.8 million within the 30 mile radius. I would like to know why PECO is continuing to build this power
