Dear Doctor Cooper:

This letter is to supply additional information relating to our amendment request dated July 8, 1980 and to correct an error in the amendment request as submitted by us.

In the amendment request we asked for authorization to use Se-75 (methionine). The isotope we intended to ask for was S-35 (methionine). Please delete the reference to Se-75 and substitute S-35.

S-35 and I-125 iodination procedures/experiments will be performed infrequently at our facility. On the days these are performed, wipe tests will be performed to determine if loose surface contamination is present. Records of these surveys will be maintained for inspection. Areas found contaminated will be cleaned and resurveyed.

Item #4 of our amendment request outlines procedures for opening packages whose activities are above and below the levels contained in 20.205 of 10 CFR. We feel that these procedures are adequate and if possible we wish to have these approved as submitted.
