DETAILS:

1. Mr. Tophan was in about his request to have his home tested for radiation, and his insulation tested for the presence of harmful chemicals. The radiation testers will be at his home on Monday, Jan. 12; he expects to hear from the other testers in the near future.

He suggests that the Radiation Protection Section do these tests routinely immediately after insulation takes place, as he feels the chemicals and radiation may dissipate in time. He does have a fear that possibly the insulation and/or radiation may have been a cause in his wife's terminal cancer and his own illness.

Requests that we get a written copy of the results from the Radiation Protection Section, and forward a copy of same to him.

2. Also, is concerned about the fact that Zion Nuclear Power Plant is located within four miles of a (minor) fault - says he can furnish the names of geologists who can substantiate this. This is certainly not a safe condition - why were studies not done about this before its construction?
