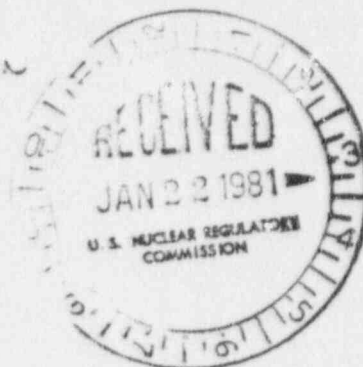

TO RETRACT THESE PLANS. I BELIEVE THAT
SUCH AN ALLOY COULD POSE A SIGNIFICANT
DANGER TO THE HEALTH OF THOSE WHO LIVE
IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO IT, BECAUSE OF THE
LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE EMISSIONS. UNLESS
THE "EXPERTS" IN THE NUCLEAR ENERGY FIELD
I AM CONVINCED THAT THERE COULD BE
SIGNIFICANT DANGERS FROM LOW-LEVEL
RADIATION, THE RESULTS OF WHICH WILL
