Please save all of us and our future children - if we get the chance to have them before some kind of cancer gets us please respond to me on this matter.

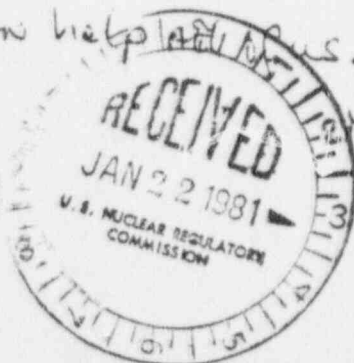
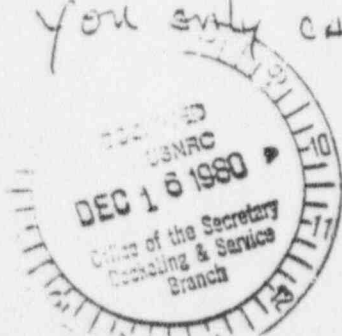
