I am writing to request an extension of the October 6 deadline for public response to the Environmental Impact Statement on the clean-up of the Three Mile Island Nuclear Power Plant. Allowing only 45 days for response to such a lengthy and comprehensive document as the statement should be seems ridiculous; I am not an unusually busy person, but I know that it will take me several days (or a couple weeks) simply to read as much of it as I want to.

Forty-five days is also not sufficient time for the preparation of expert testimony, a point which I feel is very important.

Please consider my request. I appreciate the opportunity to respond, and I would appreciate even more having sufficient time to do so.
