Call from Dan Naus to Gunter Arnold

D.N. has talked w/ Terry Renton of Quadrex, regarding analysis of test reports for diurnal effects. T.R. feels diurnal effects are design dependent, such as @ FFTF & Conn. Yankee. Not sure what data will show. T.R. offered to do it for \$5-10k. D.N. set \$5k (2 weeks equivalent @ ORNL rates) as maximum, and told me 1 week equivalent (~\$2500) would likely be minimum subcontractual amount. Exact \$ balance on B0489 in 1-2 months. I noted subcontract not to exceed remaining balance on B0489.
