

APPENDIX A

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on May 3, 1985, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violations were identified:

Condition 15 of License No. 20-12960-06 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in an application dated April 18, 1984, and letters dated July 2, 1984, July 13, 1984, and August 24, 1984.

- A. Item 8 of the attachment to the letter dated July 2, 1984 requires that thyroid scans be performed between 6 to 72 hours after each radioiodination procedure.

Contrary to the above, as of May 3, 1985, thyroid scans were only performed on a monthly basis regardless of the date(s) of radioiodination procedure(s).

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement VI)

- B. Item 1 of page 11 of the Radiation Safety Manual attached to the application dated April 18, 1984 requires that food not be carried into any restricted or controlled area.

Contrary to the above, on May 3, 1985, fruit and a can of soup, were located in a refrigerator labeled "Caution - Radioactive Material" in Room 26.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement VI)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Corning Glass Works, Biomedical Research Department is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.

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
