2 RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
3 OF FILLMORE, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF
4 ENERGY CONSERVATION.

5 WHEREAS, the City of Fillmore is vitally concerned that the
6 economic, environmental and social well-being of the State of California be
7 maintained, and

8 WHEREAS, an adequate supply of energy is critical to meeting
9 California's economic and social needs while preserving the environmental gains
10 of the past decade; and

11 WHEREAS, there is a probability that instability in the Middle
12 East will, at some near future time, result in reduced supplies of oil, thereby
13 causing further social and economic chaos here at home, and

14 WHEREAS, there must be a strong commitment to conservation of the
15 nation's limited resources and development of efficient and secure new sources
16 of energy here at home, and

17 WHEREAS, regulatory delays in the planning and licensing of needed
18 energy facilities are costly to the consumer, damaging to the environment, and
19 result in greater importation of foreign oil;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Fillmore supports

21 1. Developing alternative forms of energy such as solar,
22 geothermal and wind;

23 2. The expediting of licensing the San Onofre Units II and III
24 nuclear power plants; and

25 3. A continued commitment to conservation of our energy
26 resources.
