Please note we did not authorize the use of the Model 770, 771 or 488 source changers on your license since, you indicated Technical Operations, Inc. (Tech. Ops.) personnel would be performing all cobalt-60 source exchanges. Tech. Ops. is authorized to perform such source exchanges at temporary job sites. As such, the source change will be under Tech. Ops. licensed procedures when performed at your facility.

Additionally your license does not authorize you to perform survey meter calibrations as a service to other NRC licensees.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, the NRC expects licensees to pay meticulous attention to detail and to achieve the high standard of compliance which the NRC expects of its licensees.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. A fee may be charged for inspections in accordance with 10 CFR Part 170.
