In reference to your document dated June 4, 1981,
please amend our license to reflect the decay and
storage of radioactive waste.

Presently, we do monitor our radioactive waste to
determine that it's radioactivity cannot be
distinguished from background, prior to disposal
as normal waste.

I understand that you will automatically place
this condition on all medical byproduct material
licenses as they are issued, however, our
expiration date is December 31, 1984, and have
been advised by our physicist to request this
amendment right away.
