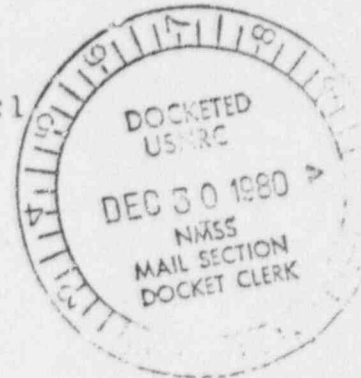

Gentlemen:

As required by 10 CFR Part 73.72, we are hereby notifying your office of an upcoming shipment of irradiated MTR fuel. This letter is a follow-up to information given to Mr. Charles Hillman with the NRC in Washington, D.C. on December 10, 1980.

The shipment is from Sweden and is due to arrive in Portsmouth, Virginia on Atlantic Container Line's "Atlantic Star" on or around December 28, 1980.

If the vessel carrying this shipment unloads on December 28, we expect to have 3 of the 4 casks enroute by 10:00 am December 29 and to complete delivery to the receiver by 10:00 pm on that day. The fourth cask is expected to be shipped at 8:00 am December 30 and delivery to the receiver should be made around 10:00 pm December 30.

The dates and times are based on the steamship line's ability to maintain the arrival date of December 28 and are subject to change.
