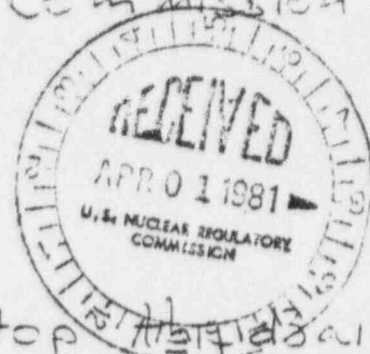

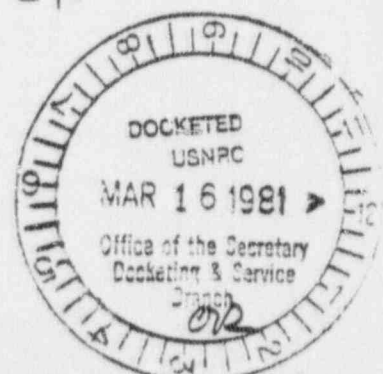
Dear Mr Ahearn
