Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. G. L. Shear of this office on May 14, 1985, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material Licenses No. 48-12272-01 and No. 48-12272-02 and to the discussion of our findings with you, Mr. Ronald Riggins and Mr. David Buchler at the conclusion of the inspection.

This also refers to subsequent telephone conversations with Dr. Warren McGonnagle on May 22, 1985 and Mr. Ronald Riggins on May 28 and 30, 1985.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in a letter by Mr. Gregory S. Holub dated November 4, 1981, regarding apparent items of noncompliance found during our September 30, 1981 inspection. We have no further questions regarding Item No. 1 of the September 30, 1981 inspection. However, Item No. 2 of the September 30, 1981 inspection is a repeat item of noncompliance and is identified in the enclosed Appendix Item No. 1. In your response to this item of noncompliance, please describe why your proposed corrective action is expected to be more successful in preventing future or similar noncompliances than the corrective action specific in your November 4, 1981 letter.

During this inspection, certain of your activities under Licenses No. 48-12272-01 and No. 48-12272-02 appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.

The responses directed by this letter (and the accompanying Notice) are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

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


