SUMMARY

DOE lawyers have advised OCDWM that "as appropriate" in Section 303 means DOE does not have to consult with us. However, Myers does not know what the Secretary plans to do. I informed him of the 2/16/84 letter from Hodel to Palladino (which requested an NRC briefing for the Panel), which states that the consultation requirement of Sec. 303 cannot be met until the Chairman is given the opportunity to review and comment on DOE's draft report to Congress. I pointed out that OCDWM was not aware of this, and plans to follow up.

The Panel report has gone to the printers and should be submitted to Secretary 1/14. Secretary has not yet responded to the DOE.




