As of November 9, 1981, we discontinued the RIA test for HBsAg and began using the EIA procedure routinely. All radioactive material associated with the HBsAg test was used in testing before November 9th or was disposed of by autoclaving, checking the radiation level with the survey meter, and discarding into the dumpster when levels were shown to be low enough. Between November, 1981, and June, 1983, the only radioactive materials on hand were less than amounts needed for 100 tests of anti-HBs. Since June, 1983, no radioactive materials have been used or stored on the premises.
