Please provide necessary amendments to the following parts of NRC License No. 34-13012-01:

1. Part 7.C to read "Sealed Sources"
2. Part 8.C to read "See Item 9.C."
3. Part 9.C to read "For possession and use in Texas Nuclear Corporation devices which have been evaluated and approved for licensing purposes and authorized for distribution under a license issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission or an Agreement State."

These specific amendments would give a general authorization to receive and use any approved device from Texas Nuclear Corporation without requesting an amendment to our license. This would make our license consistent with the previous amendments for general authorization to receive and use approved devices from Ohmart and Kay-Ray.

All other conditions of licensure will remain the same.
